



## **VENUES**

#### FILENE CENTER

Celebrating 55 years in 2025, the Filene Center is operated in partnership with the National Park Service and is home to Wolf Trap Foundation's nationally renowned summer performance seasons. Built of Douglas Fir and Southern Yellow Pine, the Filene Center is a beautiful outdoor amphitheater designed to harmonize with its National Park setting and seats 7,028. The venue hosts more than 75 performances during a typical summer, as well as two free annual celebrations with "The President's Own" United States Marine Band—the summer season kick-off, Blast Off!, and in the winter, a joyous Holiday Sing-A-Long!

Since the first performance in 1971, world-class artists from every genre, including iconic legends and current chart -toppers, grace the Filene Center stage—many returning year after year to perform in this extraordinary setting.

Over the last few years Wolf Trap Foundation and the National Park Service have worked on a series of improvements and updates to enhance the experience for audiences and artists. These projects include:

- Meadow Commons with upgraded Concessions, elevators, lounge, and more
- Entrance gates and security perimeter
- Fans in the Filene Center
- Refresh of the Filene Center's exterior

- Improved accessibility—enhanced seating, aisles, crosswalks, and elevators
- Permanent covered Pavilions and picnic areas
- Renovated backstage artist areas
- New sound system

## THE BARNS AT WOLF TRAP

Built from two historic 18<sup>th</sup>-century barns, this intimate 382-seat theater features superb acoustics. The Barns, which hosted its first season in 1982, is owned and operated by Wolf Trap Foundation and has undergone several renovations to artist spaces and patron amenities since 2018.

Programming for The Barns is as artistically diverse and discerning as the audiences that attend year-round. Patrons can enjoy performances annually between October and May, with everything from jazz greats and legendary folk singers to renowned classical musicians that are part of the *Chamber Music at The Barns* series. During the summer months, The Barns is home to the esteemed Wolf Trap Opera.



## CHILDREN'S THEATRE-IN-THE-WOODS

Music, dance, storytelling, puppetry, and more come to life at this beloved outdoor theater at Wolf Trap National Park.

Across the Meadow from the Filene Center and tucked in the woods, the 700-seat Children's Theatre-in-the-Woods is a summer tradition for generations of children and families.



## **MEADOW STAGE**

Nature and music combine at this cherished outdoor concert pavilion. Located in between the Meadow Overlook picnic areas and Children's Theatre-in-the-Woods, this smaller stage is utilized for special events throughout the summer.



#### **CENTER FOR EDUCATION**

The Center for Education at Wolf Trap is a multi-purpose facility that houses a wide range of arts and educational activities, as well as the administrative offices for Wolf Trap Foundation.

On any given day, you can find Wolf Trap Opera's summer artists busy in rehearsal, educators attending professional development workshops, or patrons enjoying preperformance lectures and special events.
